Isaiah 42:1-9 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Behold! My Servant whom I uphold,  
My <sup>2</sup>Elect One in whom My soul delights!  
I have put My Spirit upon Him;  
He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles.  
<sup>2</sup> He will not cry out, nor raise His voice,  
Nor cause His voice to be heard in the street.  
<sup>3</sup> A bruised reed He will not break,  
And <sup>4</sup>smoking flax He will not <sup>5</sup>quench;  
He will bring forth justice for truth.  
<sup>4</sup> He will not fail nor be discouraged,  
Till He has established justice in the earth;  
And the coastlands shall wait for His law."  
<sup>5</sup> Thus says God the Lord,  
Who created the heavens and stretched them out,  
Who spread forth the earth and that which comes from it,  
Who gives breath to the people on it,

Mark 1:4-11 (NKJV)

<sup>4</sup> John came baptizing in the wilderness and preaching a baptism of repentance <sup>5</sup>for the remission of sins. <sup>5</sup> Then all the land of Judea, and those from Jerusalem, went out to him and were all baptized by him in the Jordan River, confessing their sins. <sup>6</sup> Now John was clothed with camel's hair and with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. <sup>7</sup> And he preached, saying, "There comes One after me who is mightier than I, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to stoop down and loose. <sup>8</sup> I indeed baptized you with water, but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit." <sup>9</sup> It came to pass in those days that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized by John in the Jordan. <sup>10</sup> And immediately, coming up <sup>11</sup>from the water, He saw the heavens <sup>12</sup>parting and the Spirit descending upon Him like a dove. <sup>11</sup> Then a voice came from heaven, "You are My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

Our mission statement is the following:

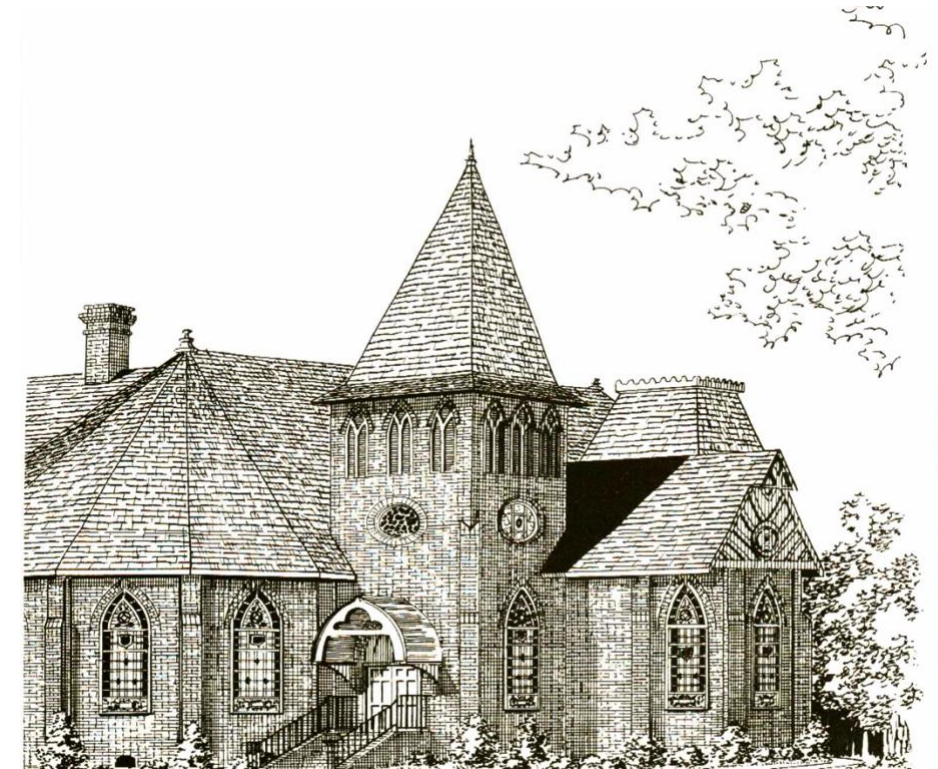
